Alberto Nespoli - Eligo Studio



Eligo Studio is an interior architecture and design practice founded in 2011 by Alberto Nespoli and Domenico Rocca, with a diverse and cross-disciplinary portfolio of projects carried out across Europe, North America, and China.

What sets Eligo Studio apart is its distinctive ability to blend traditional Italian techniques with contemporary design to shape new, modern spaces. Each project is thus unique, imbued with the charm of an Italian lifestyle. This core concept is carried through every design challenge—whether hotels, retail spaces, trade fairs, set designs, shop windows or private residences. The approach is one of bespoke design, where every detail is carefully drawn and considered. From the Latin *eligere*: to choose with care and elegance. It reflects a sensitivity to selecting reference archetypes and, from these, developing a new, superior-quality design—merging aesthetics, ethics, passion, local culture and tradition into a seamless whole. Eligo's products bring together the centuries-old expertise of Italian workshops and manufacturers, reinterpreting design through a contemporary lens, yet always inspired by historical and often forgotten models.

In 2015, Eligo Studio was awarded the prestigious **Milan Design Award** for the set design "Il sentiero dei nidi di ragno" created for Antonio Marras. Other accolades include: L'Empreinte de l'année 2015 in Paris from Les Talents du Luxe et de la Création; ADI Design Index – Eccellenza Lombarda 2019; Best Design Company – Altagamma 2019; AD Special Interior Design Issue – Top 100 Best Interior Designers in 2019. In 2020, Eligo won the BIG SEE Interior Design Award in the Hospitality category and Architecture and Design as Experience.

Alberto Nespoli and Domenico Rocca earned their Master's degrees in Interior Architecture and Design from the Politecnico di Milano in 2007. Prior to that, Alberto studied Interior Architecture at Kyushu University in Fukuoka, Japan, and at Queensland University of Technology in Brisbane, Australia. Both have worked with various design and architecture studios in Milan, Amsterdam, New York, and Berlin.

Anna Barassi - I.a.barassi architettura





He was awarded several scholarships, including the prestigious Fulbright Scholarship, which enabled him to complete a Master's in Architecture at the Southern California Institute of Architecture (SCI-Arc) in Los Angeles. He later worked as a designer and project architect at renowned international studios, including Zaha Hadid Architects in London and Fuksas Architects in Rome, contributing to large-scale international projects such as airports, museums, and skyscrapers. His work has been published and exhibited internationally, including at UCLA Los Angeles (2019), the MAK Museum in Vienna (2017), the Vienna Biennale (2017), the Tallinn Architecture Biennale (2017), and the Venice Architecture Biennale (2016).

Diego Paccagnella - Reveria





After conducting site inspections and technical surveys, and once the concept has been approved, the studio enters the **design development stage**: this includes defining the works to be carried out, identifying the necessary permits, and drafting the bill of quantities. Nomade manages each project meticulously—regardless of the country—overseeing everything from concept to on-site execution, thanks in part to a trusted network of collaborators based around the world.

Finally, the team proceeds with the **executive project**, the most accurate representation of the client's vision—defining finishes and all aspects of the interior design. The outcome is never the product of a single mind or profession, but a **blend of skills, creativity**, and—above all—the most faithful expression of the client's wishes and desires.
